Medical Device Directive



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No specific regulation until 2013-Common Framework UDI-

Make traceability of devices more efficient

- Allow easier recall
- Combat counterfeiting
- Improves Patient Safety
- Efficient data collection
- Single Use Devices

Medical Device Directive

- Harmonised mechanisms-

Point 18:

For traceability to be ensured it is not sufficient that every manufacturer has developed its own traceability mechanism.

Project Update

- National role out of basic system by 2017.
- Harmonise and Standardise data collection .
- Minimise variation in how the system is used.
- Standardise non conformances/ complaints
- Develop a centrally managed process for deviation.
- Centralised Data interpretation- e.g. Endoscopy.



Demonstrate

- Share new ideas , test and develop ideas in practice and support the spread of sustainable solutions.
